

How to set up WI-FI Calling on an iPhone

No more walking around in circles trying to get a signal. When you turn on Wi-Fi Calling, you can make calls over your phone's network connection. For this feature to work, your phone must be connected to a Wi-Fi network and have an active SIM card inserted.

To use Wi-Fi Calling, you need an iPhone 5c or later.

1. Turn on Wi-Fi calling in Settings > Phone > Wi-Fi Calling.
You may need to enter or confirm your address for emergency services.*

2. If Wi-Fi Calling is available, you'll see Wi-Fi after your carrier name in the status bar. Then your calls will use Wi-Fi Calling.

WI-FI calling is available on the major operators*. eg. Telstra, Optus, Vodafone
Telstra - All post-paid and prepaid services.
Optus – All Business services, private services available on request.
Vodafone – Most services. You may need to request it.

* It is dependant on the service provider and a compatible mobile phone.

* It is not available with service resellers such as Amaysim, ALDI, Woolworths, etc.
